MISO Zonal Resource Credits

On April 26, 2019, the Illinois Power Agency's procurement administrator, NERA Economic Consulting, received bids for the sale of Zonal Resource Credits ("ZRCs")* to Ameren Illinois Company ("Ameren") through a bidding process conducted pursuant to the procurement plan approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. 18-1564. The bidding process was monitored for the Commission by Bates White. On May 2, 2019, voting in open session, the Commission approved the procurement administrator's selection of winning bids.

In accordance with Section 16-111.5(h) of the Public Utilities Act, this public notice announces the names of the successful bidders and the average winning bid price for each contract type and for each contract term. 220 ILCS 5/16-111.5(h). In accordance with the RFP rules and previous Commission orders, quantity information is also provided where the number of successful bidders is greater than two.

* Note: Load serving entities, such as Ameren, must acquire ZRCs to satisfy certain resource adequacy requirements imposed by the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. ("MISO"). ZRCs represent a commitment of capacity from planning resources that can be relied upon by MISO.
