SUBJECT: Agenda and Notice of January 16, 2015 Teleconference Workshop Regarding the Illinois Power Agency's Alternative EEAASR Proposal Required by the Illinois Commerce Commission's Final Order in ICC Docket No. 14-0588.

The Illinois Commerce Commission's December 17, 2014 [Final Order](#) in ICC Docket No. 14-0588 directed "the parties to commence workshops, coordinated by Staff, to pursue the IPA's alternative proposal, with such workshops beginning in January and concluding by mid-February to allow the workshops to inform development of the RFPs."¹ ICC Staff is announcing a public workshop for the purpose of receiving feedback from interested stakeholders to inform the development of the utilities' Request for Proposals ("RFPs") for energy efficiency programs targeting reductions during peak periods (IPA's alternative proposal) that will be issued pursuant to Section 16-111.5B of the Illinois Public Utilities Act.²

Parties are encouraged to utilize the webinar during the teleconference because the utilities will be demonstrating how their cost-effectiveness models will be able to use a time-specific avoided energy cost that can account for the higher price of power that is offset for energy efficiency programs targeting peak periods.
