Pursuant to the Notice of Filing issued on February 23, 2018, setting March 16, 2018, as the Comment date in the above-referenced docket, the Illinois Commerce Commission (“Illinois Commission”) hereby submits this letter in support of the rate reduction sought in the Commonwealth Edison Company (“ComEd”) filing of February 23, 2018. The Illinois Commission filed a notice of intervention on March 12, 2018, and, therefore, is a party to the proceeding.

In its filing, ComEd indicates that due to the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, the overall net impact of its proposed revisions is a large rate decrease that will benefit customers over a number of years commencing at the earliest possible date. The Illinois Commission agrees that ComEd customers should receive this rate relief as soon as possible.

The Illinois Commission supports ComEd’s tariff revisions that will directly benefit its customers and urges the Commission to allow ComEd’s Formula Rate to include any necessary adjustments so that ComEd’s customers fully realize these savings in a timely manner.
