## Notice Concerning Alternative Compliance Payments associated with the Public Utilities Act's Renewable portfolio standard for alternative retail electric suppliers and electric utilities operating outside their service territories (220 ILCS 5/16-115D)

For Compliance Period: June 2013 through May 2014

Date of Notice: 1/2/2013

By its December 19, 2012 Order entered in ICC Docket No. 12-0544, the Commission has established the following parameters relating to alternative compliance payments for the June 2013 through May 2014 compliance period:

Definition	ComEd	Ameren	Units
Forecasted load of eligible retail customers at the customer meter, as established in November 2012 forecasts.	10,638,159	5,052,147	MWH
Max ACP Rate = Max allowable increase in utility rates, as established in IPA plan, ICC Docket 12-0544.	\$1.8917	\$1.8054	\$/MWH

Staff note: Estimated ACP Rates are expected to be available late spring 2013, and Actual ACP Rates will be established by July 1, 2014. For each utility, the Actual ACP Rate will be equal to the total amount of dollars that the utility contracted to spend on renewable resources for the June 2013-May 2014 period, excepting the additional incremental cost attributable to solar resources, divided by the forecasted load of eligible retail customers, at the customers' meters (shown above, unless modified by the March 2013 forecasts, as discussed in the Commission's Order, p. 110).
