PUBLIC NOTICE  
To the customers of Alhambra-Grantfork Telephone Company Alhambra-Grantfork Telephone Company (Company) hereby gives notice that on December 18, 2003 it will file a proposed tariff that makes a change in its rates, charges, or classifications resulting in a change in rates or charges for local exchange telecommunications services pursuant to Section 13-50 of the Public Utilities Act.  
(1) The proposed tariff will establish an explicit tariffed fee to be paid by wireless carriers to the Company for the termination of calls for which the Company did not previously charge a fee pursuant to a terminating wireless tariff.  
(2) The proposed rate to be paid by wireless carriers for terminating minute is \$0.036863 and Company does not currently charge a fee pursuant to a terminating wireless tariff for terminating wireless calls. This rate will not be charged to Company's residential and business customers; it will only be charged to wireless carriers.  
(3) The fee shall apply to wireless calls terminated in the Alhambra and Grantfork exchanges.  
This proposed tariff will become effective 30 days after it is filed with the Illinois Commerce Commission. The Commission must investigate whether the proposed change is just and reasonable if a telecommunications carrier that is a customer of the local exchange telecommunications carrier for 10 percent of the potentially affected subscribers of the Company file a petition or complaint with the Chief Clerk of the Commission requesting an investigation.
