I understand that it has been long time we move forward on this case, however, it is health problem which stops me moving further. It is my honor that Judge office granted benefit of doubt and good faith in request of granting extension. My health is still not proper and I am requesting an informal meeting with Mr. Huttenhower and Judge Moran in which I can support the medical documents. In coming weeks, I am visiting hospital for chest x-ray and stress echo test; dentist treatments etc. Further medical treatments depends on the result of several test performed recently. Recently, I had blood test and

few other medical examination performed including removal of one tooth. It is not that I don't have any proof for the events, however I am unprofessional and lacking knowledge which is skipping me documenting it properly. Additionally, worst depression and panics is not letting me do anything at the moments. In other word, even when I have documents in front of me, it is not letting me make a photo copy and either mail or fax it to your office. Medication also is effecting with my daily routing work / living behaviors and I feel weak, sleepy, drowsy, shaky and unfocused at the moment.

The informal meeting is primarily to satisfy defendant and honorary judge that I am sincere about the case however it is my disability which prevents me for doing things further. During the informal meeting, I can bring the evidence of hospital when I was in Emergency Room if your time permits and you like the idea of informal meeting. Alternatively, I will be happy to meet with Ms. Mosley in the lobby of SBC YAHOO to give the copy of medical records for your record with her promise of forwarding a copy either to docket or to you on my behalf.

Once again appreciate your patient.
