PETITION

Now comes the County of McLean, Illinois and requests Illinois Commerce Commission approval to modify its plan in the cause of routing 9-1-1 calls properly between the County of Woodford and McLean and in support thereof states as follows:

1. McLean County ETSB now operates an Enhanced 9-1-1 system within its political boundary as approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission.
2. That Woodford County ETSB now operates an Enhanced 9-1-1 system within its political boundary as approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission.
3. That currently McLean County has 9-1-1 calls within the Danvers, Carlock, Hudson, Gridley, and El Paso telephone exchanges directed to the McLean County 9-1-1 system from residents of Woodford County.
4. That currently Woodford County has 9-1-1 calls within the Congerville and Goodfield telephone exchanges directed to the Woodford County 9-1-1 system from residents of McLean County.

- 1 5. That Selective Routing is now available for these exchanges.
- 2 6. That a Modification be made to selectively route 9-1-1 calls within the
- 3 above listed telephone exchanges to the proper 9-1-1 system; and that
- 4 further McLean County ETSB will work with the County of Woodford and
- 5 the ICC to ensure that all citizens within Woodford and McLean County
- 6 will receive 9-1-1 service.
- 7 7. That this Modification is intended to comply with the terms and
- 8 provisions of "An Act in relation to the designation of an emergency
- 9 telephone number for use throughout the State."

11 WHEREFORE, your Petitioner, the County of McLean, Illinois, a municipal

12 corporation, prays that the Illinois Commerce Commission:

- 13 1. Give notice of and conduct a public hearing on this Petition and
- 14 Modification at the earliest possible date;
- 15 2. Enter an Order approving the Modification submitted herewith and
- 16 authorizing the implementation of the 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System
- 17 Modification described herein.
