

MANAGERIAL BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION

Carrie J. Hightman has served as President of SBC Illinois since April of 2001. As such, she is responsible for all regulatory, government and external affairs, as well as community and industry relations throughout Illinois. Prior to joining SBC in April 2001, Ms. Hightman practiced telecommunications and energy law for over 17 years as part of Schiff Hardin & Waite's Energy, Telecommunications and Public Utilities practice group. Prior to entering private practice, Ms. Hightman served as associate counsel at the Florida Office of Public Counsel. She also served as Staff Counsel at the Florida Public Service Commission.

Eileen Mitchell has served as Managing Vice President, External Affairs and Government Relations, since September 2003. In that capacity she oversees all community relations, legislative efforts and charitable giving for SBC Illinois. Ms. Mitchell joined SBC Illinois after working for 11 years in state government for Illinois House Speaker Michael J. Madigan. In addition, Ms. Mitchell served as a campaign coordinator for the Democratic Party of Illinois where she served as Political Director from 1998 until 2003.
