PETITION FOR EXTENSION

Now comes Illinois Central Railroad Company ("IC") and petitions the Illinois Commerce Commission (the "Commission") for an order giving IC an extension to comply with the mandates of the Commission in this docket. In support of its Petition, IC states as follows:

1. Pursuant to an order dated March 5, 2004, IC has until March 5, 2005 to complete work set forth in a stipulated agreement incorporated into that order.
2. Due to unanticipated problems with the original design, IC must complete new drawings and new estimates for signals, structures and drainage pipes at the at-grade crossing of County Highway 13 at the IC tracks.
3. IC shall be submitting these drawings and estimates to the Commission for approval.


4. IC may also be seeking additional funding from the Grade Crossing Protection Fund at the time it submits the revised estimates.
