21 ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE HAYNES: Mr.
22 Ward, would you like to repeat what just told me off

1 the record.

2 MR. WARD: Yes. I will be happy to.
3 Basic conversations between the parties, and a
4 conversation was just had before the beginning of
5 this hearing. The parties would be willing to
6 stipulate that the actual negotiations between the
7 parties commenced on December 26th, 2004; and,
8 therefore, the arbitration window would be pushed
9 back based upon that stipulated and understanding.

10 Pursuant thereto then, Data Net Systems
11 and TruComm Corporation would be filing a letter with
12 the ICC's clerk's office indicating withdrawal of the
13 petition while all those negotiations continue to go
14 forward.

15 ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE HAYNES: Mr.
16 Ortlieb, would you like to add anything?

17 MR. ORTLIEB: No. That's a correct
18 recitation of the arrangement between the parties,
19 your Honor.

20 ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE HAYNES:
21 Okay. Then I will look for your withdrawal of this
22 petition, and mark the record heard and taken in both

1 dockets.

2 Thank you.

3 MR. WARD: Thank you.

4 MR. ORTLIEB: Thank you, your Honor.
