1 JUDGE RILEY: Pursuant to the direction of the
2 Illinois Commerce Commission, I call Docket 05-0239.
3 This is a Joint Petition between Illinois Bell
4 Telephone Company and Sage Telecom, Inc., for
5 approval of the Fourth Amendment to the
6 Interconnection Agreement, dated April 1, 2005,
7 pursuant to 47 U.S.C., Section 252.
