**Q. PLEASE SUMMARIZE YOUR PROFESSIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL BACKGROUND.**

- A. My employment with the SBC companies began in August of 1999 in the Cost Analysis Division as Manager - Cost Analysis. In that position, I was responsible for developing incremental costs for a variety of services and UNEs, a responsibility that broadened after mergers to include the 13 states now comprising SBC's ILEC operations. In November of 2000, I became responsible for supervising a team of managers that performed incremental cost studies. Before joining SBC, I served in cost analysis and finance positions from 1997-1999 at Teltrust, Inc., then a wholesale provider of operator services/directory assistance, third-party verification, and calling-card services. Prior to my career in the telecommunications industry, I was employed as a financial analyst by Cummins Intermountain, Inc., a distributor of diesel and power generation equipment and services.

In addition to my regulatory responsibilities, I currently teach graduate and have taught undergraduate classes in managerial economics and microeconomics, respectively. I have received adjunct faculty appointments in the economics departments of Jefferson College, Southern Illinois University - Edwardsville, and Webster University, and I am currently a member of the National Association for Business Economics ("NABE"). I have attended economic and telecommunications policy symposia, and completed training courses on various industry-related topics.

I earned Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees in Managerial Economics from Brigham Young University in 1994 and 1995, respectively, and obtained a minor in Philosophy. In addition, I completed partial graduate coursework in Telecommunications at Southern Methodist University in 2000.

My testimony in multiple states has encompassed the varieties of long run incremental cost methodologies for studies spanning UNEs and services comprising much of the SBC ILECs' networks.
