WELCOME, INTRODUCTIONS & AGENDA REVIEW

Joe Cocke, Senior NPA Relief Planner – NANPA, opened the meeting with introductions, a review of the agenda and the objectives of the meeting. A list of attendees can be found in Attachment #1.

REVIEW CONSENSUS PROCESS AND MEETING MINUTES

Mr. Cocke stated that the ATIS (Alliance for Telecommunications Industry Solutions) approved industry consensus process would be followed. He reviewed the consensus process and explained the method by which consensus is determined. In addition, Mr. Cocke stated that the minutes would be comprised of consensus items. Silence on the part of the participants will be considered agreement with a proposal, based on those on the call at the time consensus is called.

PURPOSE OF THE CALL

Mr. Cocke stated that as a result of NANPA receiving three letters from separate service providers requesting the previous consensus reached at the July 26, 2005 meeting on the dialing plan be reopened. This meeting is being held per the INC guidelines and at the three service providers' request that the standard dialing plan to be included in the implementation plan be 10-Digits for all calls. NANPA conducted the meeting on August 30, 2005, during which the industry agreed to reopen the dialing plan consensus and further agreed to study the issue and to continue the meeting on September 7, 2005.

REACH CONSENSUS ON REOPENING THE CONSENSUS

Joe inquired of the attendees if they agreed to continue the call on the dialing plan and consensus was reached that the previous consensus be reopened for discussion.

REACH CONSENSUS ON DIALING PLAN

The industry agreed to reopen the dialing plan at this meeting. The issue is to either retain the previously adopted plan of 1+10 Digit Dialing for all calls – both Local and Toll HNPA & FNPA and allow 10-D dialing for Local HNPA & FNPA calls to be permissible at each service provider's discretion or to have 10-D dialing for all calls.

The dialing plan from the July 26, 2005 meeting was as follows:

Local call	Home NPA (HNPA) or Foreign NPA (FNPA)	1 + 10-digits (1 + NPA-NXX-XXXX)*
Toll call	HNPA or FNPA	1 + 10-digits (1 + NPA-NXX-XXXX)
Operator Services Credit card, collect, third party	HNPA or FNPA	0 + 10-digits (0 + NPA-NXX-XXXX)

* 10-Digit Dialing for Local HNPA and FNPA calls permissible at each service provider's discretion

Prior to the September 7, 2005 call an industry member submitted the following alternative plan for discussion:

Another industry member submitted a different alternative at the beginning of the September 7, 2005 conference call for consideration as follows:

All calls	Home NPA (HNPA)	10-digits (NPA-NXX-XXXX)*
All calls	Foreign NPA (FNPA)	11-digits (1+NPA-NXX-XXXX)**
Operator Services Credit card, collect, third party	HNPA or FNPA	0 + 10-digits (0 + NPA-NXX-XXXX)

*Permissive 11 at carrier's discretion

** Permissive 10 for local calling at carrier's discretion

After much discussion a suggestion was made and consensus was reached that the recommended dialing plan would be 10-Digit Dialing for Local HNPA & FNPA calls with 1+10D dialing at each service provider's discretion; 1+10-digit dialing for Toll HNPA & FNPA calls with 10-digit dialing at each service provider's discretion. The chart below will be included in the implementation plan to be filed with the ICC:
