Once an emergency unit has commenced a response to a request through the system, the unit will proceed to respond and render emergency service even though it is subsequently determined that the response is outside the jurisdiction of the emergency unit. If, however, it is determined by the emergency unit prior to commencement of the response that the call is outside its jurisdiction, the emergency unit may notify the dispatching service which will then notify the correct jurisdiction, if any, and the emergency unit shall have no obligation to respond to the request. This provision in no manner requires the emergency unit or its jurisdictional authority to render services outside its boundaries, except as provided above where the response is commenced prior to a determination that the call is outside the unit's jurisdiction. Likewise, in making a response outside its jurisdiction, the emergency unit is not waiving any claim that it or its jurisdiction may otherwise have for compensation from the party to whom aid is rendered. To the extent that the 9-1-1 System assigns calls for emergency service from telephone numbers which are outside an emergency unit's jurisdiction to that jurisdiction, it shall be the responsibility of the 9-1-1 System to notify such parties at the time of assignment that the emergency unit has no legal obligation to respond to calls from that number unless and until the party's property is annexed to the emergency unit's jurisdiction or enters into a contract for

emergency services to be rendered.
