**REPLY TO OBJECTION TO MOTION TO DISMISS AND SUPPLEMENTAL AFFIDAVIT**

Now come the Complainant, Florine Matthews representing herself, and replies to the Reply to Objection to Motion to Dismiss filed by the Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company, Attorney Mark L Goldstein:

- 1). Complainant stands by her allegations set forth in Objection to Motion to Dismiss.
- 2). The Complainant has been served by numerous counsels for The People Gas Light and Coke Company advising that new counsel would be representing The People Gas Light and Coke Company which institutes a non verbal agreement between the two parties for an extension. Due to the fact that this case has been in the system for almost three (3) years indicates that there have been several extensions implied by both parties. If that was not the case I'm sure The Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company would have filed for a dismissal prior to now.
- 3). Counsel failed to address the bills Complainant received prior to the one submitted with the Supplemental Affidavit dated August 26, 2003. The Commission has copies of all relevant bills that will depict amounts due ranging from over \$2,000.00 to \$1,800.00 and more. This will prove the creditability of the Complainant as it relates to this instant complaint.
- 4). The Complainant has failed to pay \$750.00 because there has not been a written settlement to that affect nor has the Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company corrected the Complainant's credit report (to this day) as evident by copies of bills dated October 26, 2005, December 27, 2005, and January 25, 2006 that all shows late payment charges and a statement at the bottom of the bills that reads, "At the time of this statement, your account was past due. Please pay (various amounts) today. Continual late payments can result in a negative credit rating, deposit request and even disconnection of service."

This case has not been adjudicated by the Commission but yet the Complainant is being penalized by The Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company by reporting negative credit rating for almost 3 years. When will I be vindicated?


The Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company has not made any reasonable attempts to resolve the differences concerning the Complainant's credit report ratings, therefore, this complaint has not been satisfied.

5). The Complainant has no problem with paying The Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company the agreed upon sum of \$750.00 but The People Gas Light and Coke Company has shown evidence (by attached bills) that they are not concerned with the Complainant's credit history and can care less if the history is corrected. The Complainant is asking The People Gas Light and Coke Company to bargain in good faith and do what is morally correct by the Complainant.

6). The Complainant still state that Brian Schmoldt was not apart of this initial complaint. Record of evidence will reveal that fact by documentation contained in the Commission file Docket No. 03-0332.

7). Please be advised that the Complainant will be on location in Chicago from February 10, 2006 through March 02, 2006. Please allow additional time if correspondence is sent to her address in Dallas Texas.

WHEREFORE, The Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company, Complainant respectfully requests that the complaint filed by the Complainant on May 19, 2003 will not be dismissed without prejudice.




