David Aronow — President

Mr. Aronow is a co-founder Empire Payphones, Inc. and has also served as President of MetTel since 1996. Andoni Economou — Executive VP, Chief Operations Officer

Mr. Economou is the Executive VP and COO of Empire Payphones. He has also served as the COO and Executive VP of MetTel since 1996.
