ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE’S PROPOSED ORDER

By the Commission:

The Illinois Commerce Commission Corporation (“Commission”) entered a Citation Order initiating the instant proceeding against PT-1 Long Distance, Inc. (“Respondent”), a telecommunications carrier as defined in Section 13-202 of the Public Utilities Act, for failure to file an Annual Report. A Staff report recounts that Respondent failed to file its 2005 Annual Report by March 31, 2006, as required by Section 5-109 of the Public Utilities Act (220 ILCS 5/5-109) and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 210. The Order directed Respondent to appear at the offices of the Commission in Chicago, Illinois, to show cause why the Commission should not rescind its certificate or take other action.

Pursuant to notice given in accordance with the law and the rules and regulations of the Commission, this matter came on for hearing before a duly authorized Administrative Law Judge of the Commission at its offices in Chicago, Illinois on August 9, 2006. Respondent did not appear. Counsel for Commission Staff appeared and recommended that Respondent’s certificate be revoked for failure to file its 2005 Annual Report, which shows Respondent has insufficient managerial resources and abilities to provide intrastate telecommunications services. At the conclusion of the hearing, the record was marked “Heard and Taken”.

The Commission, having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, is of the opinion and finds that the certificate granted to the Respondent should be cancelled and revoked because the Respondent does not possess the necessary managerial resources and abilities to provide intrastate telecommunications services in Illinois.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that the Certificate of Service Authority granted to PT-1 Long Distance, Inc., be, and is hereby, cancelled and revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that resolution of this citation proceeding does not relieve Respondent from the requirements of the Public Utilities Act to file annual reports or to pay any penalty for failure to do so.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.
