**General & Intangible Plant (G&I)**

This issue has already been granted rehearing by the Commission.

**Distribution O&M**

The CCC disagrees with the conclusion on this issue. No new or additional evidence was presented to justify rehearing on this issue. Therefore, rehearing should be denied.

**Incentive Compensation**

The CCC disagrees with the conclusion on this issue. No new or additional evidence was presented to justify rehearing on this issue. Therefore, rehearing should be denied.

**Capital Structure**

The Commission already granted rehearing on this issue based on the rehearing petition filed by ComEd.

**Cost of Long-Term Debt**

The CCC point out that the language in the conclusion on this issue is inconsistent. Therefore rehearing should be granted on this issue for the limited purpose of clarifying the language.

**Cost of Common Equity**

The Commission has already granted rehearing on this issue based on the rehearing petition filed by ComEd.
