Depreciation Reserve

The Attorney General argues that the record does not support the Commission's conclusion. No new or additional evidence was provided. Therefore, rehearing on this issue should be denied.

Non-Recurring Severance

The Attorney General ("AG") disagreed with the conclusion reached on this issue. No new or additional evidence was provided on this issue. Therefore, rehearing on this issue should be denied.

Incentive Compensation

The AG disagreed with the conclusion reached providing any incentive compensation to the Company. No new or additional evidence was provided with the rehearing petition. Therefore, rehearing on this issue should be denied.

Capital Structure

This issue has already been granted rehearing by the Commission on the petition from ComEd.

Salary and Wage Expense

The AG disagreed with the conclusion reached on this issue. No new or additional evidence was provided. Therefore, the petition for rehearing on this issue should be denied.

Pension Asset and Pension Expense

The Commission has already granted the petition for rehearing filed by ComEd on this issue.
