SUBJECT: Loretta Kidd

Complaint as to service in Chicago, Illinois.

RECOMMENDATION: Enter attached Order (dismissal with prejudice).

Loretta Kidd had full and fair opportunity to pursue her complaint, filed November 18, 2005, before the Illinois Commerce Commission (“Commission”). The record shows, however, that she did not take advantage of this opportunity or comply with the rules, procedures or directions of this agency. The Respondent detailed the telling facts in a Motion to Dismiss filed on May 30, 2006. Among her other omissions in this proceeding, Ms. Kidd did not respond to this pleading.

On August 15, 2005, the Administrative Law Judge assigned to this case issued a Proposed Order recommending that the motion to dismiss be granted. Only the Respondent filed exceptions and only to correct scrivener errors. For her part, the Complainant filed nothing.

The ALJ recommends that the Commission adopt the instant Order, which includes the Respondent’s proposed word changes and, in substance, acts to dismiss, with prejudice, the complaint filed by Loretta Kidd.
