

proceeding as described in the Commission's Order. (See *Citizens Utility Board*, Ill. C.C. Docket No. 05-0691 (Final Order, Feb. 8, 2006) ("*CUB Order*") at 3-4) Neither the Motion nor the Response focus on reliability issues, so there does not appear to be anything for Staff to respond to in that regard. Nevertheless, Staff's view that reliability issues could be a proper subject for investigation has not changed since the *CUB Order*. However, Staff notes that the concerns raised in Docket 05-0691 have been addressed, the current Petition does not raise any reliability issues related to pending Commission decisions (only potential legislative action), and the Petition does not appear to contain allegations indicating there is an imminent reliability concern absent legislative action.
