

The following Certificates of Public Need and Necessity were issued by the Illinois Commerce Commission to IPL or its processor company, Interstate Power Company in regards to transmission facilities identified in the Asset Sale Agreement:

43554 issued September 20, 1956. Transmission line from East Dubuque to Galena in Jo Daviess County, Illinois.

45715 issued April 8, 1959. Transmission line from Albany, Illinois to Galena, Illinois.

50289 issued May 5, 1964. Transmission line from the 161 kV East Dubuque-Galena Transmission Line to the Mississippi River adjacent to East Dubuque, Jo Daviess County, Illinois.

51811 issued December 20, 1965. Transmission line in the vicinity of Albany, Illinois, County of Whiteside, Illinois.

56710 issued October 6, 1971. Transmission line in the vicinity of East Dubuque, Illinois, County of Jo Daviess, Illinois.

85-228 issued August 28, 1985. Transmission line in Cordova Township, Rock Island County, Illinois.

94-0356 issued July 6, 1995. Although Certificate was granted specifically to Central Illinois Public Service Company d/b/a AmerenCIPS, the certificate included approval for a portion of a 161 kV line to be constructed and owned by the Iowa utility, IES Industries. The line is a 2.1 mile, 161 kV line running from the Niota, Illinois substation to the banks of the Mississippi River. The line crosses the Mississippi River crossing to the Iowa side of the river and into the Burlington Generating Station. Interstate Power Company merged into IES Industries for form IPL.
