PETITION FOR CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

Now comes RME Illinois, L.L.C., ("RME Illinois" or "Petitioner") and pursuant to Section 8-406 of the Illinois Public Utilities Act (the "Act"), 220 ILCS 5/8-406), hereby requests that the Commission grant a certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing it to provide Onsite Wastewater, Collection and Dispersal Services ("Wastewater services") to a certain parcel located in Long Grove, Lake County, Illinois. The Petitioner contends that approval of the Petition is in the public interest in that its services will benefit consumers and, in support thereof, the Petition states as follows:

- 1) Petitioner is a limited liability company created and existing in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois as evidenced by Exhibit One (1) and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2) Petitioner has been requested to provide Onsite Wastewater, Collection and Dispersal Services to Eastgate Subdivision in the area designated in Exhibit "A" by the Developer and by the Lake County Health Department.. The proposed legal description of the service area is described in Exhibit "B".

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3) The Lake County Health Department has approved the installation of the system to serve Eastgate Subdivision a 9 lot single family subdivision in the Village of Long Grove, Lake County, Illinois

- 4) Wastewater services are not available from any other utility company in the proposed service area. The municipalities whose corporate boundaries lie within one and one-half (1 ½) miles of the property have been served with a copy of this petition, as required by Section 200.150(b) of the Illinois Commerce Rules of Practice, 83 Ill.Adm.Code 200.150(b).
- 5) Petitioner ultimately anticipates providing wastewater services to 9 single family homes in Long Grove, Lake County, Illinois under RME Illinois, L.L.C. utilizing standard rates, rules and regulations in effect from time to time.
- 6) RME Illinois, L.L.C. acquisition, operation and maintenance of the onsite treatment facilities for the Service Area is necessary to provide adequate and efficient onsite treatment services to the customers within the area for which certification is sought. In addition, Petitioner's proposed certificate constitutes the most desirable means of satisfying the service needs of those customers while protecting the public as a "Management Model 5: RME Ownership" as described by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in "Voluntary National Guidelines for Management of Onsite and Clustered (Decentralized) Wastewater Treatment Systems" (EPA 832-B-03-001 dated March 2003)
- 7) RME Illinois is capable of efficiently managing and supervising construction necessary to serve the parcel.

- 8) Petitioner has the technical and managerial ability to operate and maintain the onsite treatment facilities for the service area.
- 9) The acquisition, operation and maintenance by RME Illinois, L.L.C. of the onsite sewer facilities necessary and appropriate to serve the parcel for which certification is requested will promote the public convenience and are necessary thereof, and the interests of the public will be served thereby.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, RME Illinois, L.L.C. respectfully requests that the Commission issue a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing RME Illinois, L.L.C. to own, operate and maintain the facilities necessary and appropriate to serve the proposed service area in Long Grove, Lake County, Illinois shown on Exhibit "A", and to transact business of furnishing onsite treatment services to the public therein, and grant such further relief as may be just and reasonable.




