1 In this matter -- or also ask, does
2 the Company still propose to file their direct
3 testimony on or before August 10 in this matter?

4 MS. SULLIVAN: Yes, Your Honor.

5 JUDGE YODER: And then Staff and any
6 intervenors would file their direct testimony on or
7 before October 30, 2007, and we would come back for a
8 status hearing which could be evidentiary should
9 there be no contested issues on November 14, 2007.

10 And, Ms. Sullivan or Mr. Kahle, I have
11 that whole day open. Does any time work better for
12 you, Ms. Sullivan, on the 14th?

13 MS. SULLIVAN: Any time that day would be fine.

14 MR. KAHLE: Anything is fine.

15 JUDGE YODER: Why don't we just say 10:00
16 o'clock again.

17 If the matter is not resolved then on
18 November 14, Company would file rebuttal testimony on
19 or before December 11, 2007. Staff would file any
20 rebuttal testimony on or before January 9, 2008.
21 Company would then file any surrebuttal testimony on
22 or before January 16, 2008. And we would have an

1 evidentiary hearing then on January 23, 2008.

2 And say 9:00 o'clock on the 23rd?

3 MR. KAHLE: That's fine for Staff.

4 MS. SULLIVAN: Yes, that's agreeable to the
5 Company.

6 JUDGE YODER: Okay. We will set then an
7 evidentiary hearing, assuming it is not resolved at
8 the earlier status hearing, for 9:00 o'clock on
9 January 23, 2008.

10 After adopting that schedule, anything
11 else to address in this matter, Ms. Sullivan?

12 MS. SULLIVAN: None for the Company.

13 MR. KAHLE: Nothing for Staff.

14 JUDGE YODER: All right then. I will enter
15 that schedule as agreed to by the parties and it is
16 fine with me. And I also have no objection at the
17 November 14 status hearing if the parties wish or
18 need to appear telephonically.

19 MS. SULLIVAN: Thank you, Your Honor.

20 JUDGE YODER: Okay, thank you.
