PROCEEDINGS

JUDGE ALBERS: By the authority vested in me by the Illinois Commerce Commission, I now call Docket Number 07-0371. This docket concerns a petition filed by Illinois-American Water Company. The Company seeks authority to incur \$28,500,000 of indebtedness and approval of affiliated interest transaction.

3 MS. PHIPPS: Yes, Your Honor.

4 JUDGE ALBERS: All right. Those dates or that
5 schedule seems fine to me. And at that status
6 hearing then we will evaluate Staff's next move, so
7 to speak.

8 And is there anything further for the
9 record today?

10 MR. STURTEVANT: Nothing from the Company, Your
11 Honor.

12 MS. PHIPPS: And I don't have anything.

13 JUDGE ALBERS: Okay, that's fine. Thank you,
14 all, and I will continue this to July 19 at 9:30 a.m.
