RESPONDENT'S 30-DAY STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW Respondent The Kansas City Southern Railway Company (KCSR) and provides the following 30-day status report pursuant to the Commission's Order of July 11, 2007:

1. On Wednesday, August 8, 2007, a contractor was on the premises to move and rearrange lockers and benches. This work could not be completed on August 8. The contractor will return next week to complete the moving and rearranging of lockers and benches. Excess lockers will be removed from the modular units at that time.

2. Lunch room furniture is already in place in the modular unit that will be used for the lunch room and office for all craft employees (formerly the mechanical employees locker room). The tables and chairs in what was formerly the lunchroom for transportation employees will be removed next week.

3. The hole in the floor at the north end of the modular unit that will be used for locker rooms for all craft employees has been repaired.


4. A bid has been let to Quality Rail to install a partition, doorway, and door at the west end of the hallway outside the bathroom in the modular unit that will be used for locker rooms for all craft employees. Quality Rail is scheduled to begin this remodeling work the week of August 13, 2007.

5. On August 10, 2007, KCSR's Information Technology personnel are scheduled to move office furnishings and equipment from the north end of the modular unit that will be used for locker rooms for all craft employees to the modular unit that will house the lunch room and office for all craft employees (formerly the mechanical employees locker room).

6. KCSR management has advised the cleaning contractor of the complaints that have been made about the cleanliness of these facilities and has requested the contractor to be diligent in keeping the facilities clean. KCSR management will continue to monitor the cleanliness of the facilities.

7. On September 10, 2007, KCSR will submit a final report regarding the status of bringing the facilities into compliance with the remediation plan. It is anticipated that the facilities will be in full compliance with the remediation plan by that date.

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
