
How to hide channels, set parental locking and movie rating controls.

AT&T U-verse puts you in charge of who watches what. You can block live programs, recorded programs, and videos you don't deem appropriate for all members of your household. You can even set limits on who can order and watch on-demand videos.

Hiding channels from view

Remove channels you don't want to see in your *guide* or when browsing channels.

- 1 Press **menu**, select *options*, and use the **down arrow** to select *channel options*. Press **OK**.
- 2 Select *customize channels*; press **OK**.
- 3 Use **up/down arrows** to scroll through the list of available channels. Press **OK** to uncheck (hide) or check (see) channels. When you're done, select *save* and press **OK**. (Tune to hidden channels anytime using the **number/letter** buttons.)



Using parental locking

To block access to select programming and channels, a Personal Identification Number (PIN) is entered to view locked programs.

SETTING UP A PIN FOR PARENTAL LOCKING

- 1 Press **menu**; use the **right arrow** to select *options* from the menu bar. Select *channel options*; press **OK**.

- > A picture of a lock will appear next to the *parental locking* menu item if a PIN is already set and locking is in effect.
- > No lock means that no PIN has been set.
- > An open lock means that a PIN is set but no parental locks are in effect.

- 2 Use **up/down arrows** to select parental locking; press **OK**. The *settings* screen appears.
- 3 If no PIN is set, press **OK**, then use the **number/letter** buttons to enter a 4-digit PIN. (Use **delete** to erase a wrong entry.)
- 4 If a PIN is already set, enter the correct PIN to access the *settings* screen. You can lock rentals, specific channels, and more.
- 5 Press **menu** or **guide** to return to either of these main screens, or **last** to return to the last channel viewed.

LOCKING & UNLOCKING SPECIFIC CHANNELS

- 1 In *settings*, select *channels* and press **OK**. The *lock channels* screen appears. If a channel is already locked, a lock symbol will appear next to it.
- 2 Use the **up/down arrows** to select a channel you want to lock or unlock. Press **OK** to make a lock symbol appear next to an unlocked channel. To unlock a channel, press **OK** to clear the lock symbol.
- 3 To unlock all locked channels, select *unlock all*; press **OK**. To view only the locked channels, select *view locked only*; press **OK**.



- 4 To restore the full list of locked and unlocked channels, select *view all channels*, then press **OK**.
 - 5 Select *save* and press **OK**.
- LOCKING PROGRAMS BASED ON RATINGS**
- In *settings*, select *movie ratings* or *TV ratings* and press **OK**. Select the lowest rating you want locked, and press **OK** to lock programs with that rating and higher. To unlock all ratings, select *unlock all*, then press **OK**. Select *save*, and press **OK**.

LOCKING & UNLOCKING ON-DEMAND VIDEOS AND PAY PER VIEW

- 1 In *settings*, select *rentals* and press **OK** to see the *lock renting* screen.
- 2 To lock rentals, use the **right arrow** to select the *lock renting* check box, then press **OK**. A lock symbol appears. (To unlock rentals, press **OK** again to clear it.)
- 3 Select *save*, then press **OK**.

TURNING OFF SETTINGS FOR JUST 4 HOURS

To temporarily turn off parental locking, access the *settings* screen, select *turn off locking*, and press **OK**. Select *unlock all TV for 4 hours* and press **OK**. The *parental locking* menu item in the general *settings* screen will show an open lock.

Note: If you have locked rentals, you must still enter a PIN to purchase programs.

RESTORE ALL PARENTAL LOCKING SETTINGS

Select *lock* in the *parental locking* screen and press **OK**. Or turn the receiver off, then press the **power** button again to restore all parental locking settings.

DELETING A PIN & ALL LOCKING SETTINGS

Select *turn off locking* and press **OK**. Select *reset all parental locks* and press **OK**. Confirm as asked and press **OK**. You'll be returned to the last channel tuned. (You'll have to create a new PIN next time.)


What's PIP?

Choose the onscreen menu language you want to read

Use your menu options to read onscreen messages and menus in your language.

- 1 Press **menu**, select *options*, then *system settings*; press **OK**.
- 2 Select *on-screen language*; press **OK**.
- 3 Use the **up/down arrows** to highlight the language you want and press **OK**.
- 4 Select *save*, and press **OK**.



Tech terms. Easy definitions!

Key terminology for your AT&T U-verse TV:

- > **Aspect ratio:** the relationship of your TV screen's width to its height. For example, a standard TV size of 4:3 means 4 inches of width for every 3 inches of height; 16:9 means there are 16 inches of screen width for every 9 inches of height.
- > **HDTV:** High-Definition television is the newest standard when it comes to television viewing. HDTV showcases programming and content filmed in High Definition; almost every program in prime time on ABC, CBS, and NBC is in HD. HDTV offers spectacularly beautiful picture quality and sound, creating a theater-like experience in your home.
- > **Pixel:** (short for "picture element") tiny dots that convey light and combine to form a video picture on your TV.
- > **Resolution:** the number of vertical pixels viewable onscreen. The higher the better for picture definition. (HDTV can contain 720 or 1080 vertical pixels; standard is 480.)
- > **TV programs:** AT&T U-verse TV programming is delivered to your home as streams of data that allow viewing or recording of up to four programs simultaneously.
- > **TV signal:** a standard TV signal is comprised of 486 visible lines, while a High-Definition signal is comprised of up to 1080 visible lines. While straight math seems to indicate that means an HD signal would be slightly more than twice as sharp, due to the way the eye perceives the amount of lines, an HD signal actually results in a picture up to 6 times sharper than the same image sent with a standard definition signal.



Change the aspect settings to fit your TV

When you purchase a new television such as an HDTV, you'll want to match the output of the AT&T U-verse receiver to your new TV. (Read about AT&T U-verse HDTV on p. 14.)

- 1 Press **menu**, select *options*, then *system settings*, and then *aspect ratio*.

- 2 Use the **arrows** to select *4:3 standard definition*, *widescreen standard definition*, *720p High Definition*, or *1080i High Definition* and press **OK**.
- 3 Use the **arrows** to select *continue* and press **OK**.

Enlarge or shrink the image you see on your HDTV

If you watch non-HD (standard-definition) programming in widescreen mode on a widescreen HDTV, black bars will appear on the sides of the program. To remove/minimize the bars, press **enter** on your remote.

- 1 Press **enter** to see the current zoom setting onscreen.
- 2 Before the zoom symbol disappears, press **enter** repeatedly to change from one setting to the next until you reach the zoom you want. There are five settings:

- > **Normal:** displays the normal image.
- > **Zoom 1 to 3:** increases the zoom.
- > **Stretch:** expands the image to fill the screen (may cause distortion of picture).
- 3 Wait for the zoom symbol to disappear.

Note: Zoom will affect all channels, not just the one you've changed settings on.

Here we answer some common questions about your AT&T U-verse TV.

Frequently Asked Questions

? Will the DVR record on more than one TV in my home?

Presently, DVR features work on one receiver connected to any TV.

? Can you record with the DVR and watch another channel?

Yes, you can record up to three different programs on your DVR and still watch a fourth channel.

? Can parental locking be used with Video on Demand (VoD)?

Yes, once you set up a PIN, parental controls can be used for VoD, TV, and movies. All parental controls will require the use of a PIN. Please remember to keep your PIN in a safe place because the PIN-reset process is not immediate and parental control functionality will experience downtime.

? If a program is locked, do I need a PIN to record it?

You do not have to enter a PIN to schedule recordings for programs locked by the parental locking feature, but viewers do have to enter a PIN to watch the program while it's recording or to view it at any time thereafter.

? How many receivers with DVR functionality can I have in my home?

AT&T U-verse offers one receiver with DVR functions per household, but the U-verse service (for most packages) includes up to three free receivers.

? Why do I need a Wireless Gateway?

This professionally installed device enables reception and distribution of AT&T U-verse TV and wireless Internet home networking, which lets you connect to the Internet and to other devices such as printers without wires anywhere in your home, at the same time.

? Will AT&T U-verse TV service have any impact on my burglar alarm?

We do not anticipate any interference with your existing burglar alarm.

? What is the expected installation downtime and installation duration?

Expect to be out of service for four hours or more during installation, depending on the installation requirements.

? Whom should I contact if there is a disruption in my TV service?

You should call 1-800-ATT-2020 to report connection problems. This number should be used to report any problems you encounter.

? Can anyone in my family report trouble to Customer Care?

Yes, please call 1-800-ATT-2020 and be ready to provide your telephone number, a description of the problem, and how often it occurs.

Troubleshooting Guide

THE RECEIVER WON'T TURN ON

Check that the unit is plugged in. If it is, try plugging another device into the socket to make sure power is flowing to it. If the power is working, there may be something wrong with your remote control.

THE REMOTE WON'T CONTROL THE RECEIVER

Unplug the device for a few seconds and then plug it back in.

THERE IS VIDEO, BUT NO SOUND

First check to see if the volume is muted by pressing **mute** or **+** on the **vol** button. Try changing the channel to see if the problem is only with that one channel. If your system uses standard video or S-video connectors, be sure that you have connected the audio-out jacks on the receiver to the audio-in jacks on your TV or audio receiver.

SOUND IS GOOD, BUT PICTURE IS POOR

Check the connections of your video cables to make sure they are properly seated in their jacks. Also, try changing the channel to be sure that the problem is not just on that one channel. If you have no connection after five minutes, make sure all the connections to your receiver are secure. If you're still having problems, call for technical assistance at 1-800-ATT-2020.

ONSCREEN MESSAGE SAYS "SIGNAL TEMPORARILY NOT AVAILABLE"

Try changing the channel to see if the problem is only with that one channel. If it appears on more than one channel, there is a problem with the signal. Call for technical assistance at 1-800-ATT-2020.

MY RECEIVER WILL NOT RESPOND

The green LED surrounding the receiver's power button should flash each time a

remote button is pressed. If this happens, but the receiver does not respond to your commands, you may need to perform a restart. To restart your receiver, press and hold the **power** button for 5 seconds. If you are still experiencing problems, call for technical assistance at 1-800-ATT-2020.

THE REMOTE IS NOT WORKING

Make sure there isn't anything in the path between the remote and the remote sensor on your receiver. Be sure you are aiming your remote at the receiver. You have to be within 20 feet of the receiver for the remote to work properly. If these steps don't solve the problem, try replacing the batteries in your remote. (For remote battery replacement instructions, see p. 12.) Call 1-800-ATT-2020 for more help.



2 ways to access your email

- > **Web-based email** offers you online access from any Internet-connected computer. Log in at mail.yahoo.com
- > **Client-based email** (POP/SMTP) uses email software like Outlook Express to download email to your computer.

SETTING UP YOUR MAIN EMAIL ACCOUNT FOR CLIENT-BASED EMAIL

Below you'll find key server information:

- > Email address: MemberID@sbcglobal.net
- > Incoming (POP): pop.sbcglobal.yahoo.com
- > Outgoing (SMTP): smtp.sbcglobal.yahoo.com (SMTP authentication required)
- > Incoming mail server: POP3
- > Incoming mail port number: 110
- > Outgoing mail port number: 587

You should find the authentication check box in the *outgoing mail* section of your account screen setup of your email client. If your email client does not support SMTP authentication, you won't be able to send email from your AT&T Yahoo! Mail account.

Note: If you're having trouble sending or receiving email, the problem could be incorrect settings. Go to help.sbcglobal.net for assistance.

CREATING EMAIL SUB ACCOUNTS

You can create up to 11 email accounts (all have a private address, 2GB of storage, and a customizable homepage). To create a sub account:

- 1 Open your AT&T Yahoo! Browser and click on the *my account* link.
- 2 Scroll down to the sub accounts area, and select *create new sub account*. Have your main account password handy.

- 3 You'll be guided through the process of choosing a unique Member ID and an account password.
- 4 Once you've agreed to the terms of service, click on *create sub account*.
- 5 You can then choose to have Outlook or Outlook Express configured to receive mail for this account, and add the account to AT&T Yahoo! Messenger. Make your selections and click *next*. Sub account is activated!


