**PETITION OF TRANSCANADA KEYSTONE PIPELINE, LP  
REQUESTING THE COMMISSION TO RE-OPEN THE DOCKET  
AND ISSUE AN AMENDATORY ORDER BASED ON A CHANGE  
TO THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROPOSED PIPELINE**

To the Illinois Commerce Commission:

TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP (“Keystone”), pursuant to Sections 8-503, 8-509, 15-101 and 15-401 of the Public Utilities Act (“Act”), 220 ILCS 5/8-503, 8-509, 15-101 and 15-401, and 83 Ill. Admin. Code §200.900, requests that the Commission (i) re-open the above-captioned docket for the purpose of receiving additional evidence concerning a change to the design and construction of the proposed pipeline that is the subject of this docket, and (ii) after receiving, and based on, the additional evidence, issue an amendatory order confirming that the authorizations and approvals granted to Keystone in the Commission’s April 4, 2007 Order herein (“April Order”) remain valid and in effect. In support of these requests, Keystone states as follows:

**I. Background**

1. On June 19, 2006, Keystone filed a petition (“Petition”) with the Commission requesting an order issuing Keystone a certificate in good standing pursuant to §15-401 of the Act; authorizing Keystone to operate, as a common carrier by pipeline, a pipeline (the “Keystone

Pipeline”) extending from an entry point into Illinois near Hartford, Illinois, to a terminus in Patoka, Illinois; authorizing, pursuant to §15-401 of the Act, the construction and operation of the proposed Keystone Pipeline for the transportation of crude petroleum in interstate commerce; authorizing and directing Keystone, pursuant to §8-503 of the Act, to construct, install and maintain the proposed Keystone Pipeline; and authorizing Keystone, pursuant to §8-509 of the Act, to exercise the power of eminent domain, to the extent necessary, to acquire permanent easements and additional temporary construction workspace easements, with the temporary easements to revert to the respective landowners upon completion of construction of the Keystone Pipeline.

2. On April 4, 2007, after an evidentiary hearing, the Commission issued the April Order granting Keystone a certificate in good standing to operate the proposed Keystone Pipeline; authorizing and directing Keystone to construct, operate and maintain the Keystone Pipeline in Illinois; and authorizing Keystone to take and condemn property for easements, as more specifically described, and subject to the conditions set forth, in the April Order, along the route described in the Appendix to the April Order.

3. Subsequent to issuance of the April Order, Keystone has decided to implement a change to the design and construction of the Keystone Pipeline from the design and construction described in Keystone’s Petition and attachments thereto and in the testimony Keystone submitted at the evidentiary hearing in this docket. Specifically, as described below, Keystone must increase the diameter of the Keystone Pipeline on the approximately 55-mile segment from Wood River to Patoka from 24 inches to 30 inches. This change does not require any change to the route of the Keystone Pipeline in Illinois, and will not result in Keystone requesting or obtaining larger easements from landowners along this portion of the pipeline route than the

easements described in the April Order. However, so that no question is raised that the change to the design and construction of the Keystone Pipeline takes the Keystone Pipeline outside the scope of the design and construction described in the Petition and evidence in the original proceedings in this docket, and which the Commission considered in issuing the April Order and granting the authorizations therein, Keystone is requesting that the Commission (i) exercise its authority to reopen this docket to receive evidence on the change to the design and construction of the Keystone Pipeline that has occurred, and (ii) issue an amendatory order confirming that the authorizations granted in the April Order (as summarized in paragraph 2 above) remain valid and in effect.

## **II. Pipeline Diameter**

4. In its Petition and in the testimony submitted in the original proceedings in this docket, Keystone stated that the Keystone Pipeline in Illinois would consist of approximately 1.4 miles of 30-inch diameter pipeline from its point of entry into Illinois at the Mississippi River near Hartford, Illinois, to a point near the ConocoPhillips refinery at Wood River, Illinois; and approximately 55 miles of 24-inch diameter pipeline from Wood River to the terminus at Patoka, Illinois.<sup>1</sup> (*See, e.g.*, Petition at 3 and 5; Keystone Ex. 1.0 (Jones Direct) at 5; Keystone Ex. 3.0 (Koski Direct) at 2.) At these diameters, the Keystone Pipeline would have the capacity to deliver approximately 435,000 barrels per day (“bpd”) of crude petroleum to terminals at Wood River and Patoka. (*See* April Order at 7.)

5. Subsequent to issuance of the April Order, Keystone has determined to increase the diameter of the approximately 55-mile segment of the Keystone Pipeline from Wood River to

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<sup>1</sup>As described in the original Petition, it was initially planned that the Keystone Pipeline would include a 1.1-mile lateral of 30-inch diameter pipe to the ConocoPhillips refinery. However, due to changes in the proposed route of the Keystone Pipeline, the 1.1-mile lateral became unnecessary and was eliminated. (*See* Keystone Ex. 8.0 (Corrected) (Koski Additional) at 2.)

Patoka to 30 inches, with the result that the diameter of the Keystone Pipeline will be 30 inches for its entire length in Illinois. At this diameter, the Keystone Pipeline will have the capacity to deliver approximately 590,000 bpd of crude petroleum to the terminals at Wood River and Patoka. Keystone has determined to increase the diameter of the pipeline segment from Wood River to Patoka to 30 inches for the following reasons:

(a) Keystone continues to see growth in demand from shippers for capacity on the Keystone Pipeline. As the result of an “open season” process for the Keystone Pipeline, contracted demand has increased from 340,000 bpd to 490,000 bpd, which exceeds the original design capacity of the Keystone Pipeline (435,000 bpd).

(b) In connection with the need to increase the capacity of the Keystone Pipeline, Keystone conducted a review of the hydraulic design of the Wood River-to-Patoka segment. This review determined that a 30-inch pipeline diameter would be a more efficient design for this segment than the original 24-inch design in terms of electric power consumption and quality of the crude petroleum. That is, a 30-inch diameter design for this segment will require less electric power for pumping, and will better preserve the quality of the crude petroleum being shipped, than would a 24-inch diameter design.

6. However, the increase in pipeline diameter on the segment of the Keystone Pipeline from Wood River to Patoka will not result in Keystone requesting or obtaining any larger (wider) temporary or permanent easements than were described in the Petition and testimony in the original proceedings in this docket and authorized in the April Order. As summarized at page 16 of the April Order, Keystone witness Koski described the easement requirements for the Keystone Pipeline as follows:

Keystone witness Koski, Vice President of Energy Service with Trow Engineering Consultants, Inc., testified that Petitioner will require permanent easements along the right-of-way of the pipeline with a width of 50 feet. He stated that a 50-foot easement is required to allow reasonable access to the pipeline for maintenance purposes and repairs and to minimize the potential of damage to the pipeline from third parties. In addition, during the construction phase additional temporary construction easements will be required with a width of 60 feet on those portions of the pipeline that will be 30-inch diameter pipe and a width of 45 feet on those portions of the pipeline that will be 24-inch diameter pipe. He stated that further additional temporary construction workspace easements will be needed in certain areas, to accommodate specific design and construction requirements associated with road, river, railway and utility crossings and other situations involving varying soil, terrain and structure issues. (Keystone Ex. 3.0 at 6-7, 11.) He stated that once construction is completed, the temporary work spaces will revert back to the landowners and Keystone will have no further rights to utilize this land. (*Id.* at 14.)<sup>2</sup>

The April Order (at page 28) authorized Keystone to utilize eminent domain, if necessary, to acquire temporary and permanent easements in the following widths:

. . . TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP is authorized to take and condemn 50 feet wide nonexclusive permanent easements, additional temporary construction easements 60 feet wide along the portion of the pipeline that will be 30 inch diameter pipe and 45 feet wide along the portion of the pipeline that will be 24 inch diameter pipe, and such further temporary construction easements as are needed to accommodate specific design and construction requirements associated with road, river, railway and utility crossings and other situations involving varying soil, terrain and structure issues, along the route described in the Appendix to this Order and on the tracts of land listed in Keystone Exhibit 9.2 in this Docket for which TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP has not acquired the necessary permanent and temporary easements through voluntary negotiations with the landowners.

Keystone states that for the entire length of the 55-mile segment of the Keystone Pipeline from Wood River to Patoka, which will now be 30-inch diameter pipe, Keystone will continue to require only (i) 50-foot wide nonexclusive permanent easements, and (ii) additional 45-foot wide temporary construction easements, except in such locations that additional temporary construction easements are needed to accommodate specific design and construction

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<sup>2</sup> See also Petition at 5-6.

requirements associated with road, river, railway and utility crossings and other situations involving varying soil, terrain and structure issues. Therefore, the increase in the diameter of the Keystone Pipeline to 30 inches for the segment from Wood River to Patoka will not result in Keystone requesting or obtaining any larger easements from any landowners along this portion of the route than would be the case were the pipeline diameter to remain at 24 inches.<sup>3</sup> As described in the original proceedings in this case, Keystone will continue to obtain 50-foot wide permanent easements and additional 60-foot wide temporary construction easements along the approximately 1.4-mile segment of the Keystone Pipeline from the Mississippi River to Wood River that was originally (and still is) planned to be constructed with 30-inch diameter pipe.

7. In addition, for the Commission's information, Keystone advises the Commission that Keystone has obtained a special permit from the Pipeline Hazardous Materials Safety Administration ("PHMSA"), U.S. Department of Transportation ("USDOT"), authorizing Keystone to design and construct the Keystone Pipeline to 80% (0.80) of the specified minimum yield strength ("SMYS") of the steel pipe used in the pipeline, rather than 0.72 SMYS as specified in PHMSA's regulations at 49 C.F.R. §195.106. PHMSA is authorized to issue special permits for operation at different design factors than those specified in its regulations, such as the special permit that has been issued to Keystone, if PHMSA finds that the authorization granted by the special permit is "not inconsistent with pipeline safety". The authorization granted by the

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<sup>3</sup>Keystone is not requesting any change to the text of the authorizations granted in the April Order. However, in light of Keystone's intentions with respect to the Wood River to Patoka segment of the Keystone Pipeline, as stated above, Keystone would not object if the first sentence of the authorization to use eminent domain, at page 28 of the April Order, were revised to state: "TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP is authorized to take and condemn 50 feet wide nonexclusive permanent easements, additional temporary construction easements 60 feet wide along the portion of the pipeline from the Mississippi River to Wood River, Illinois and 45 feet wide along the portion of the pipeline from Wood River to Patoka, Illinois . . . ."

special permit is subject to the exceptions, limitations and conditions set forth therein.<sup>4</sup> The special permit was issued by PHMSA on April 30, 2007.<sup>5</sup>

8. Keystone stated in its original Petition in this docket that it would be regulated by the Office of Pipeline Safety within the PHMSA, USDOT, on construction, safety and operations matters, and that construction and operation of the Keystone Pipeline will comply with all applicable rules, regulations and construction standards. (Petition at 7.) Attachment G to the Petition, "Project Description," stated that the segment of the pipeline that would be 30-inch diameter pipe would have a 0.375-inch minimum pipe wall thickness (based on an X80 steel grade) and the segment of the pipeline that would be 24-inch diameter pipe would have a 0.343-inch minimum pipe wall thickness. Keystone witness Cowling testified that the proposed facilities will be designed, constructed, tested and operated in accordance with all applicable requirements included in the regulations at 49 CFR Part 195 and other applicable federal and state regulations, which are intended to ensure the safe delivery of crude oil. (Keystone Ex. 2.0 (Cowling Direct) at 2.) The April Order noted Keystone's testimony that the Keystone Pipeline will be designed, constructed, tested and operated in accordance with applicable requirements

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<sup>4</sup>The authorization granted by the special permit does not apply to pipeline segments (i) operating in high consequence areas ("HCAs") described as commercially navigable waterways in 49 CFR 195.450, (ii) operating in HCAs described as high population areas in 49 CFR 195.450 or (iii) operating at highway, railroad and road crossings; or to piping located within pump stations, mainline valve assemblies, pigging facilities and measurement facilities.

<sup>5</sup>Keystone requested the special permit for the entire length of the Keystone Pipeline in the United States, from the U.S.-Canada border in Cavalier County, North Dakota, to Patoka, Illinois (as well as the Cushing Extension from Jefferson County, Nebraska to Cushing, Oklahoma). The special permit issued by PHMSA, however, states that is applicable to the Keystone Pipeline from the U.S.-Canada border to Wood River, Illinois (and the Cushing Extension), with no explanation as to why the entire route of the pipeline in the U.S. is not covered. Keystone believes this deviation from the requested special permit was an unintended clerical error by PHMSA. Keystone has asked PHMSA to issue a corrected special permit stating that it applies to the entire route of the Keystone Pipeline in the U.S., but has not yet received the corrected special permit.

including 49 CFR Part 195, and concluded that Keystone has detailed plans for meeting the applicable requirements in 49 CFR Part 195 in the design, construction and operation of the Keystone Pipeline. (April Order at 8 and 23.) Based on the special permit issued by PHMSA (once it is corrected as described in footnote 5), the Keystone Pipeline will have a 0.386-inch minimum pipe wall thickness (based on an X70 steel grade) for its entire length in Illinois. Thus, Keystone will continue to meet its commitment that the design, construction and operation of the Keystone Pipeline in Illinois will be in compliance with USDOT's regulations at 49 CFR Part 195 and with other applicable rules, regulations and standards.

### **III. Notice to Interested Governmental and Private Entities, including Landowners**

9. Keystone is providing notice of this Petition to the potentially interested pipelines, railroads, electric utilities, telecommunications carriers, county boards, municipalities, and federal, state and local agencies listed on **Attachment A** to this petition. **Attachment A** is the Notification List that was provided as Attachment A to Keystone's original Petition in this docket, updated to incorporate such name and address changes, additions and deletions as have come to Keystone's attention.

10. Keystone has also notified landowners along the route of the Keystone Pipeline, by letter, of the change in pipeline diameter on the segment from Wood River to Patoka. **Attachment B** provides the text of the letter that was mailed to landowners on or about September 28, 2007 via the U.S. Postal Service, first class mail. **Attachment C** is a list of the names and addresses of the landowners on the route of the Keystone Pipeline to whom the letter was mailed. An informational package concerning the proposed Keystone Pipeline was previously mailed to each of these landowners, as required by the Commission's regulations in 83 Ill. Admin. Code Part 300. As noted earlier, the change to the design and construction of the

Keystone Pipeline described herein does not require any changes to the route of the pipeline in Illinois, nor to the width of the temporary or permanent easements required by Keystone from any landowner.

#### **IV. Testimony**


11. In support of its request, Keystone is submitting with this filing the prepared testimony of Robert Jones, Keystone Exhibit 11.0. This testimony describes and explains the basis for the change in pipeline diameter from 24 inches to 30 inches on the pipeline segment from Wood River to Patoka and explains that this change will not result in any changes to the route of the Keystone Pipeline or to the width of the temporary or permanent easements required by Keystone along this segment of the pipeline. This testimony also provides information on the special permit issued by PHMSA.

#### **V. Conclusion**

For the reasons set forth herein and in the accompanying testimony being filed herewith, TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP respectfully requests that the Commission (i) re-open the this docket for the purpose of receiving additional evidence concerning the change to the design and construction of the Keystone Pipeline described herein, and (ii) after receiving, and based on, such additional evidence, issue an amendatory order confirming that the authorizations and approvals granted to Keystone in the Commission's April 4, 2007 Order in this docket remain valid and in effect.

I am writing to update you on some recent changes TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP ("Keystone") will implement regarding the design and construction of the Keystone Pipeline. Keystone has chosen to increase the diameter of the Keystone Pipeline on the approximately 55 mile segment in Illinois, from Wood River to Patoka, from 24 inches to 30 inches. This change will not require any additional permanent or temporary rights-of-way. Keystone will install the 30-inch pipeline within the 95-foot construction right-of-way that was planned for the 24-inch pipeline, as described initially in Keystone's application to the Illinois Commerce Commission.

This change is the result of a successful open season, whereby Keystone announced that contracted volumes on the pipeline would increase to 495,000 barrels per day (bpd) from 340,000 bpd.
