This Accessible Letter is being sent to notify CLECs that a new wholesale performance remedy plan ("AT&T Midwest Remedy Plan") and a new set of performance measurements (documented in the AT&T Midwest Performance Measurements User Guide version 3.0 and referred to as the "PM User Guide") (collectively referred to as "the Plan") have been negotiated and agreed to by the participants in the recently completed Midwest Six Month Review of Performance Measurements. CLECs were notified of this collaborative and invited to participate via Accessible Letter CLECAM06-174 dated June 2, 2006.

Changes to Current Performance Measurements/Remedy Plans

The AT&T Midwest Remedy Plan proposes to modify the current Commission-approved State remedy plans, including the remedy plan structure. The participants in the collaborative, including Commission Staffs, agreed to eliminate Tier 2 remedies (payable to the State) and modify Tier 1 remedies (payable to CLECs) by increasing the per occurrence and per measure remedy payouts. The parties intend to file the Plan with the State Commissions in each of the AT&T Midwest states later this month. The parties will ask the Commissions to replace any existing State-approved performance remedy plans¹ with the revised PM User Guide and the AT&T Midwest Remedy Plan. A December 1, 2007 effective date is being requested so that remedy payments issued in February for December performance would reflect the new Plan.

Participation in the Plan

In most cases CLECs will become participants in the Plan without amending their current interconnection agreement ("ICA"), or taking any other action, because their ICA expresses an intent to use the most current commission-approved performance measures/remedy plan ("auto evolve").

Where a CLEC's interconnection agreement does not reflect any type of auto evolve approach, or a CLEC does not currently have an effective performance measures/remedy plan, or the plan the CLEC has is different from the state commission plan, an ICA amendment will be required to

participate in the Plan. In order to give the parties time to amend their ICAs, the joint filings will propose that the AT&T Midwest Remedy Plan apply to those CLECs upon the effective date of the Plan and for a period of time up to three months after the effective date. AT&T will notify individual CLECs in writing where an amendment may be required to continue participation in a remedy plan and will provide a proposed amendment form.
