2 EXAMINER WALLACE: Pursuant to the direction
3 of the Illinois Commerce Commission I now call Docket
4 Number 00-0129. This is the matter of GTE North
5 Incorporated, GTE South Incorporated and PV Tel.
6 This is a joint petition pursuant to 47 U.S.C.
7 Section 252 (i) regarding an Interconnection
8 Agreement.

9 May I have appearances for the record,
10 please?

11 MR. HARVEY: On behalf of the Staff of the
12 Illinois Commerce Commission, Matthew L. Harvey,
13 spelled H-A-R-V-E-Y, 160 North LaSalle Street, Suite
14 C-800, Chicago, Illinois 60601.

15 EXAMINER WALLACE: Thank you. Let the
16 record reflect there are no other appearanceso at
17 today's hearing. The record should reflect that a
18 Tracy Pagliara filed this petition on behalf of GTE
19 Service Corporation. Mr. Pagliara is not present nor
20 did he contact the Hearing Examiner concerning this
21 hearing. Upon contacting Mr. Pagliara's office, the
Hearing Examiner was informed that this is probably

1 an outside counsel. However, the outside counsel has
2 not contacted the Hearing Examiner. The record
3 should also note that the Telecommunications Staff
4 person is not present in the hearing room either.

5 So with this in mind; Mr. Harvey has
6 requested time to send out data requests and submit a
7 verified statement on behalf of Staff. That request
8 is granted. Mr. Harvey, you would like how much time
9 for the data requests?

10 MR. HARVEY: We would request a date of
11 March 1 for us to send our data requests. In the
12 past, Mr. Hearing Examiner, compliance with the data
13 requests which have generally not been terribly
14 exhaustive has been possible within a seven-day time
15 period and we would request that responses to all
16 data requests be in hand by March 8, and that Staff
17 thereafter have until March 20 to file its verified
18 statement. I have a certain amount of difficulty
19 representing to you that, since we can't -- we know
20 very little about who are the parties here other than
21 ourselves -- that we can do this in hand but we will
22 make every effort to serve data requests and the

1 verified statement in hand to the parties on the date
2 that I have designated here.

3 We would request that an evidentiary
4 hearing be held after March 20, any date that the
5 Hearing Examiner deems appropriate.

6 EXAMINER WALLACE: I have failed to bring my
7 calendar down with me. I do have a hearing, I'm not
8 sure, I think it's the entire third week of March.
9 So maybe, what's March 31, do you know?

10 MR. HARVEY: March 31 is a Friday.

11 EXAMINER WALLACE: How about let's go ahead
12 and set it for like March 30?

13 MR. HARVEY: That would be fine, Mr. Hearing
14 Examiner, with the Staff. And what time of day would
15 that be?

16 EXAMINER WALLACE: 9:30. Does that work?

17 MR. HARVEY: 930 is fine with the Staff.

18 EXAMINER WALLACE: All right then. Your
19 request for dates are granted. The March 1 to send
20 out the data requests, March 8 to receive them back,
21 March 20 for a verified statement and March 30 for
22 continued hearing.

1 MR. HARVEY: Thank you, Mr. Examiner.

2 EXAMINER WALLACE: Thank you, Mr. Harvey.

3 And if you hear from any of the parties, if you would
4 inform me on what transpired. If I hear from them, I
5 will do likewise.

6 MR. HARVEY: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. I
7 will give any party that contacts me, I will give
8 them notice of today's proceeding and ask them to
9 contact the Examiner so that you can have his address
10 and information.

11 EXAMINER WALLACE: All right. Thank you. I
12 will talk to you later.

13 (Whereupon the hearing in this
14 matter was continued until
15 March 30, 2000, at 9:30 a.m.
16 in Springfield, Illinois.)
