**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE OF
PSEG ENERGY RESOURCES & TRADE LLC**

1. Now comes PSEG Energy Resources & Trade LLC and (“PSEG ER&T”), and submits this Petition For Leave To Intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support thereof, PSEG ER&T states as follows:

2. On October 29, 2007, Commonwealth Edison Company (“ComEd”) filed with the Illinois Commerce Commission (the “Commission”): (i) a petition for approval of its initial procurement plan as required by Section 16-111.5 of the Public Utilities Act; and (ii) a petition for approval of tariffs implementing a new competitive procurement process and recovering procurement costs.

3. PSEG ER&T engages in extensive marketing of electric energy and capacity in the northeastern region of the country. PSEG ER&T’s parent company, PSEG Power LLC, (“PSEG Power”) owns approximately 10,000 megawatts of capacity within the region administered by the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”). PSEG ER&T has provided service to support default service requirements in a number of states. In New Jersey, PSEG ER&T

provides significant levels of “Basic Generation Service” (“BGS”), wholesale default supply, to the New Jersey electric distribution companies (“EDCs”). In addition, PSEG ER&T has provided support for EDC default services in Maryland, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, Connecticut and Rhode Island.

4. As participant in wholesale and retail markets in the PJM region, and as a potential future supplier of full requirements service to ComEd, PSEG ER&T has substantial interest in ComEd’s procurement policies. Other participants in the proceeding cannot adequately represent PSEG ER&T’s interests.

5. PSEG ER&T agrees to accept service by electronic means as provided for in Section 200.1050 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice. (83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.1050).

6. **WHEREFORE**, PSEG ER&T respectfully submits that the Commission grant this Petition For Leave To Intervene. For purposes of receiving service in the proceeding, PSEG ER&T requests that the following persons be placed on the official service list:






