To Whom It May Concern:

1. On or about April 2006, I contacted the utility company to turn the power on at 630 Alexander St. Peoria Illinois. This is not in dispute. The utility company has on record my correct billing address, and previous billings from this address were mailed to my home address in Morton IL.
2. On the same month a new tenant signed a lease for the Alexander St. property. In the language of the lease the responsibility to pay the utilities belongs to the tenant. This is clearly stated in the lease agreement.
3. The net result is that the tenant did not transfer utility liability. I had no way of knowing this as I did not live at the address the statements were being sent. Has Cilco sent the bills to the correct address this would have been nipped in May or the latest by June 2006.
4. I have a lease agreement that I can produce. I have past billing statements showing Cilco billing the utility costs for the Alexander address to my home address in Morton IL. I have a signed affidavit from the tenant acknowledging the liability for the cost of the utilities.

I would like the commission to hold the utility company accountable for their miss billing of the account. I have attempted to reach a settlement with the company and they will not accept any responsibility.
