Complaint as to estimated billing/inaccurate billing.

RECOMMENDATION: Enter Order granting Motion to Dismiss Complaint.

On September 11, 2000, Maxine Johnson ("Complainant") filed a complaint against Commonwealth Edison Company ("Respondent" or "ComEd") alleging that she had been overbilled for services.

Pursuant to notice given in accordance with the law and the rules and regulations of the Commission, this matter came on for a status hearing before a duly authorized Hearing Examiner of the Commission at its offices in Chicago, Illinois. This case was subsequently consolidated with Docket 00-0608, a similar complaint brought by a Ms. Betty Johnson. However, prior to this matter convening for the evidentiary hearing, the Complainant and Respondent reached a settlement in this docket. Thus, on December 27, 2000 the parties filed a Joint Motion to Dismiss and the Hearing Examiner severed this docket from Docket 00-0608 on January 9, 2001.

Accordingly, the Commission grants the Motion To Dismiss and dismisses the proceedings without prejudice by Yellow Sheet.
