RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Form 3 petition was filed as aforesaid pursuant to 92 Ill. Adm. Code 1535.400(d) seeking approval by X-Resolution of plans showing details of a proposed change at the subject grade crossing; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission staff has examined the petition and plans and is of the opinion that the proposed change should be authorized.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Illinois Vehicle Code 625, ILCS 5/18c-7401, the rail carrier shall be responsible for the installation of temporary stop signs and the maintenance until the luminous flashing signal or crossing gate devices have been installed.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the proposed change as shown by the petition and plans filed as aforesaid be and it is hereby authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that petitioner shall submit to the Director of Processing of the Commission's Transportation Division, within five (5) days of completion of the work herein authorized, a U.S. DOT Crossing Inventory Form (6180.71) as a notice of said completion.
