In response to the electronic notice received on May 12, 2008 requesting additional information regarding Shell Energy North America (SENA)'s ARES application, I am providing the following answers.

1) Subsection 451.20(e)(3):

SENA has no affiliated companies that sell electricity to customers in the United States. Numerous affiliates purchase power for their own end uses.

2) Subsection 451.20(f)(1):

Coral Energy Holding, L.P. changed its name to SENA on October 1, 2007. Therefore, our original certificate from the Illinois Secretary of State's office is in the name of Coral Energy Holding, L.P. There is an amendment attached that shows the Illinois Secretary of State's acceptance of our name change to SENA. SENA is authorized to do business in Illinois. **Please see Attachment 1.**

3) Subsection 451.30(a):


