12 appearances? Let the record show there are not.

13 It is my understanding that the
14 parties want to use this hearing as an evidentiary or
15 final hearing today, is that right?

16 MR. LOUNSBERRY: Yes.

17 MR. TOMC: That is correct, Your Honor.

18 JUDGE JONES: Is the Company ready to go
19 forward to offer its prefiled testimony?

20 MR. TOMC: Yes, Your Honor. On April 11 of
21 2007 AmerenCILCO filed direct testimony in this
22 docket. AmerenCILCO has also filed as exhibits to

1 the respective testimony of the AmerenCILCO witnesses
2 affidavits in support of those pieces of testimony.
3 And at this time Ameren CILCO would list off the
4 exhibits filed that contain the testimony and
5 exhibits attached to those testimonies and would move
6 for entry of those testimonies and schedules and
7 exhibits into the record in this case.

8 I will begin with AmerenCILCO Exhibit
9 1.0, the testimony of Paul W. Mertens, Exhibit 1.1,
10 Exhibit 1.2, Exhibit 1.3, Exhibit 1.4, attachments to
11 that testimony.

12 Then I would add AmerenCILCO Exhibit
13 2.0, the direct testimony of Cynthia Foerstel,
14 Exhibits 2.1, 2.2, Exhibits 2.3 and 2.4, Exhibit 2.5,
15 attachments to the AmerenCILCO direct testimony of
16 Cynthia Foerstel.

17 I would also add AmerenCILCO Exhibit

19 3.1, Exhibit 3.2, the exhibits attached to
20 Mr. Dothage's testimony.

21 Ameren would move that those

2 JUDGE JONES: Thank you. What did you say
3 about the affidavits?

4 MR. TOMC: Your Honor, affidavits in support of
5 each of the three pieces of direct testimony have
6 been executed in support of those testimonies. Those
7 exhibits would be Exhibit 1.4, Ameren Exhibit --
8 just a moment, Your Honor.

9 (Pause.)

10 AmerenCILCO Exhibit 2.5 as well as Ameren
11 exhibit -- AmerenCILCO Exhibit 3.2.

12 JUDGE JONES: Thank you. Any objection to the
13 admission of those?

14 MS. PEARCE: No, Your Honor.

15 MR. LOUNSBERRY: No.

16 JUDGE JONES: Let the record show those are
17 admitted into the evidentiary record. They were
18 admitted as filed electronically on e-Docket April
19 11, 2007, AmerenCILCO Exhibits 1.0, 1.1, 1.2, 1.3 and
20 1.4.

21 Also entered are AmerenCILCO Exhibits
22 2.0 in public and proprietary versions, 2.1 and 2.2

1 in public and proprietary versions, and 2.3 and 2.4

6 an accountant in the Accounting Department of the
7 Financial Analysis Division of the Illinois Commerce
8 Commission. I am presenting ICC Staff Exhibit 1.0
9 entitled the Direct Testimony of Bonita A. Pearce
10 which was filed on e-Docket May 29, 2008. My
11 testimony consists of a cover page and two pages of
12 written testimony. I have no changes, additions or
13 modifications to this exhibit. If I were asked the
14 same questions today, my answers would be the same.
15 I am offering ICC Staff Exhibit 1.0 for admittance
16 into the record of this proceeding.

17 JUDGE JONES: Thank you. Any objection? Let
18 the record show there is not. Accordingly, ICC Staff
19 Exhibit 1.0 is admitted into the evidentiary record
20 as filed electronically on May 29, 2008, and as
21 reflected in the e-Docket entry.

22 (Whereupon ICC Staff Exhibit 1.0

4 JUDGE JONES: Mr. Tomc, will AmerenCILCO be
5 preparing a draft order for filing in this matter?

6 MR. TOMC: Yes, Your Honor, AmerenCILCO can
7 prepare a draft order and will do so.

8 JUDGE JONES: In terms of the process there, do
9 you plan to send a copy that of draft to the
10 Commission Staff?

11 MR. TOMC: Yes, Your Honor. Prior to filing
12 the draft order, a draft will be sent to Commission
13 Staff for review.

14 JUDGE JONES: And by when do you propose to
15 send that draft to Staff?

16 MR. TOMC: Your Honor, a draft order could be
17 prepared on or before June 27 for Staff review.

18 JUDGE JONES: Assuming that happens, how long
19 would Staff propose it have to review that?

20 MS. PEARCE: I think two weeks would be
21 sufficient.

22 MR. LOUNSBERRY: July 11.

1 JUDGE JONES: All right. Staff proposes July
2 11 to get back to the Company with respect to that
3 draft order. So assuming those two dates are
4 implemented by then, when would the Company propose
5 to make the filing of the suggested order with the
6 Commission?

7 MR. TOMC: Your Honor, the Company would be
8 prepared to be able to review that draft order and
9 any changes that Staff has thereto and have it ready
10 to present to the Commission and be filed on or
11 before July 21 of 2008.

12 JUDGE JONES: All right. Those are the dates
13 that are proposed. Does anybody have any objection
14 to any of those dates?

15 MR. LOUNSBERRY: No.

16 MS. PEARCE: No.

17 JUDGE JONES: All right. They do not. Let the
18 record show that scheduling is hereby put into place.
19 It will result in a suggested order being filed by
20 AmerenCILCO on or before July 21, 2008.

21 I think that may do it. Does anybody
22 have anything else before we conclude this hearing?

1 MR. TOMC: I have nothing further, Your Honor.

2 JUDGE JONES: All right. At this time then let
3 the record show that today's hearing is over. Our
4 thanks to Mr. Tomc for causing the call-in number to
5 be circulated.
