
To the Illinois Commerce Commission:

The **Village of Burr Ridge** hereby gives notice that it proposes to make a change, designated as a minor change under 92 Illinois Administrative Code 1535.400 (b) and (c) in crossing Number **004345J** located near **Village of Burr Ridge**, being the crossing of **Madison Street**, with **double main line**. A full statement of the proposed changes are as follows:

Village of Burr Ridge intends to install a 5-foot mast extension to the Remote Confirmation Signal located 600 feet west of the crossing. The existing mast is north of main 1 and must be extended for train crew visibility.
