

Dear Sirs:

The City of DeKalb caused 6<sup>th</sup> Street between Route 38 and Locust Street to change from two-way travel across Crossing No. 175 041N to one-way northbound following Union Pacific Railroad gate and signal changes at this crossing in April and May 2007. The crossing was closed in early May 2007 to accommodate the UP one way gate and signal changes, and 6<sup>th</sup> Street was reopened May 4, 2007 at the completion of City signing and pavement striping to fully implement the one-way northbound travel as the signal crossing work was complete.
