ILLINOIS COMMERCE COMMISSION  
STIPULATED AGREEMENT 1370**

This Agreement made and entered into, by and between the State of Illinois acting by and through the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission"), the Union Pacific Railroad Company ("Company") and the State of Illinois, Department of Transportation ("Department" or "IDOT").

**WITNESSETH:**

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2000, the Commission entered an Order in Docket T00-0095 requiring and directing the Company to install remote monitor units at one thousand fifty three (1,053) of its highway-rail grade crossings in Illinois equipped with automatic warning devices. The devices were designed to continually monitor the warning system at each location and electronically report instances of extended commercial power failures, high/low standby battery voltage limits, suspect gate operations and excess warning operation directly to the Company's 24-hour Call Center. The monitors ordered to be installed in Docket T00-0095 utilize analog signal technology; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Commission through informal communication between its staff and the Company that analog signal technology used in the monitors is being discontinued and replaced with digital signal technology. Inquiry should be made into the matter of improving public safety by replacing the existing analog monitors with digital signal technology at local road public highway-rail grade crossings of the Company's tracks equipped with automatic warning devices in Illinois. Remote monitoring devices are not components of a signal safety system as defined in 49 CFR 234, in that a malfunction in a remote monitoring device would not adversely affect the actual operation of a crossing's electronic signal system. In addition, a railroad cannot guarantee the local cellular telephone service which the remote monitoring devices utilize; and

WHEREAS, the crossings included in this Commission project should be grouped for purposes of executing multiple Stipulated Agreements with budgeting considerations. This Stipulated Agreement includes two hundred ninety seven (297) local road highway-rail grade crossings of the Company's rail lines where freight trains operate, as listed on Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the parties are mutually agreeable to accomplish the proposed improvements upon a determination of the Commission by Order.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and agreements as hereinafter contained the parties pray that the Commission enter an Order according to the provisions of Section 18c-7401 of the Illinois Commercial Transportation Law, 625 ILCS 5/18(c)-7401, requiring that certain improvements as hereinafter stated be made and that the cost for the proposed improvements be divided among the parties

according to law and that in the interest of the traveling public the Grade Crossing Protection Fund ("GCPF") of the Motor Fuel Tax Law be required to bear a substantial portion of the cost; To Wit the parties agree as follows:

**Section 1** All improvements encompassed by this Agreement shall be made in accordance with all applicable State laws, rules, standards, regulations and Commission Orders and procedures in general.

**Section 2** The parties are of the opinion that the following improvements should be performed in the interest of public safety at those crossings listed on Exhibit A attached hereto:

- (a) Replacement of existing analog monitor units with digital signal technology, by the Company.

**Section 3** The Company has prepared a detailed estimate of the cost to accomplish the proposed improvements, which may be required by Commission Order. The estimate is attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit B.

**Section 4** The Company shall upon Commission Order, according to the requirements contained therein, proceed toward the completion of the proposed improvements, accomplishing the work with its own forces or appropriate contracted services and agrees that an appropriate time for the completion of the proposed improvements should be one (1) year from the date of Commission Order approving this Agreement.

**Section 5** The parties hereto agree that an equitable division of cost for the proposed improvements should be as follows:

<sup>1</sup> Total Grade Crossing Protection Fund (GCPF) assistance for material costs not to exceed \$301,069; any material costs above the estimated amount of \$301,069 will be paid by the GCPF in the same percentage shown above, upon submittal and review of evidence to support the additional cost and approval by the Commission.

<sup>2</sup> Company responsible for all labor costs to replace the existing remote monitor units with digital signal technology remote monitor units, and all future maintenance costs associated with the units.

Section 6 Local roadway authorities are not required to pay any portion of the cost for the proposed improvements.

Section 7 Special Provisions. The Company shall complete and submit the Project Manager Information portion of the Project Status Report sheet, attached as Exhibit 1, along with this executed Agreement.

The Company shall, within six (6) months from the date of Commission Order approving this Agreement, submit to the Director of Processing and Information, Transportation Bureau of the Commission, a Progress Status Report, attached as Exhibit 1, regarding the progress it has made toward completion of the work required by this Agreement. The Progress Status Report shall include the Commission Order's docket number, the Commission Order date, the project completion date as noted in the Commission Order, crossing information (Inventory Numbers and Railroad Mileposts), type of improvement, and the name, title, mailing address, phone number, facsimile number and electronic mailing address of the Company Project Manager.

All bills for work at those crossings listed on Exhibit A attached authorized for reimbursement from the Grade Crossing Protection Fund shall be submitted to the Fiscal Control Unit, Bureau of Local Roads and Streets, Illinois Department of Transportation, 2300 S. Dirksen Parkway, Springfield, IL 62764. The Department shall send a copy of all invoices to the Director of Processing and Information, Transportation Bureau of the Commission. All bills shall be submitted to the Department no later than twelve (12) months from the completion date specified in the Commission Order approving this Agreement. The final bill for expenditures shall be clearly marked "Final Bill". The Department shall not obligate any assistance from the Grade Crossing Protection Fund for the cost of proposed improvements described in this Agreement without prior approval by the Commission. The Commission shall, at the end of the 12<sup>th</sup> month from the completion date specified in the Commission Order approving this Agreement or any Supplemental Order(s) issued for this project, conduct a review to determine if any unused assistance from the Grade Crossing Protection Fund should be deobligated. Upon completion of the review, the Commission shall notify the Department to de-obligate all residual funds accountable for this project. Notification may be by regular mail, electronic mail, fax, or phone.

Progress billing will be based upon the work performed during the billing period. Progress payment for material will be based on the actual cost of material purchased and received by the Company during the billing period.

Section 8 Billing: For all work specified in Section 2 of this Agreement, and authorized by an Order of the Commission, the Company shall assure that sufficient documentation for all bills is made available for review by the Department or the Department's representative. The minimum documentation that must be made available is outlined below:

- a) Material - An itemized list of all materials purchased and installed at the crossing locations. If materials purchased are installed at multiple crossing locations, a notation must be made to identify the crossing location.
- b) Incidental Charges - An itemized list of all incidental charges along with a written explanation of those charges.
- c) Service Dates - Invoice shall include the beginning and ending date of the work accomplished for the invoice.
- d) Final or Progressive - Each invoice shall be marked as a Progressive or a Final Invoice.
- e) Reference Numbers - Each invoice shall include the AAR/DOT numbers, the ICC order number and the state job number when federal funds are involved.
- f) Locations - Each invoice shall show the locations, with the street names and AAR/DOT crossing inventory numbers.

Section 9 This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their successors or assigns. Upon execution of this Agreement by all parties, the Commission shall enter an appropriate Order, within 60 days accepting or rejecting such stipulation according to the provisions contained herein.
