25 authority and explaining why a grant of eminent domain authority was required for
26 the Unsigned Parcels, which testimony is reaffirmed here. For the reasons set forth
27 in Petitioners' direct testimony and exhibits, Petitioners agree with Mr.
28 Linkenback's recommendation at Paragraph 6 of his affidavit, that the Commission
29 grant Petitioners eminent domain authority for the Prairie West Line.

30 **IV. ADDITIONAL AGREEMENTS REACHED WITH LANDOWNERS**

31 **Q6. Have Petitioners reached agreement for easements with any of the owners of**
32 **the Unsigned Parcels?**

33 A. Yes. Since the filing of my direct testimony, Petitioners have negotiated easements
34 with Landowners A, C, D, E, and F on Ameren Exhibit 1.3, covering 46 of the
35 Unsigned Parcels. Therefore, Petitioners are now seeking eminent domain
36 authority with respect to 64 remaining parcels owned by Landowners B, C, and G.

37 **Q7. Does this conclude your testimony?**

38 A. Yes.
