PETITION

NOW COMES petitioner, VILLAGE OF SAVOY, and respectfully petitions the
Illinois Commerce Commission (Commission) as follows:

1. Petitioner is a municipal corporation located in Champaign County in the State of Illinois.
2. ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY, a Corporation, is a registered rail carrier operating in the State of Illinois.
3. There is an existing vehicular crossing of the ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY, rail track at Church Street (AAR/DOT 289 086 M, Milepost 132.18-W) in the Village of Savoy.
4. The petitioner requests to install a pedestrian crossing link approaching sidewalk on the south side of Church Street.
5. If approved and constructed, the Petitioner will reimburse ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY; for cost incurred for the engineering and

installation of the proposed pedestrian crossing, as shown in the attached proposed plan (Exhibit A).

6. If it is determined by the Commission that additional crossing warning devices are required, and the ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY; is required to provide additional warning devices, then the Petitioner will reimburse ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY, for all installation costs.
7. Petitioner requests that its proposed plan (Exhibit A) be approved by the Commission as complying with any and all requirements.
8. Petitioner requests that the request for a pedestrian crossing sought in this petition be granted without a hearing.
9. The facts set forth in this Petition and any and all attachments are true and correct to the best of the Petitioner's knowledge and belief.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner prays that the Commission approve its proposed plan (Exhibit A) as complying with any and all requirements without a hearing and enter an order authorizing Petitioner to install a pedestrian crossing and perform all associated work as deemed necessary for completion of the plan.
