1 JUDGE HAYNES: By the authority vested in me by
2 the Illinois Commerce Commission, I now call Docket
3 No. 01-0061, Illinois Bell Telephone Company and
4 NuStar Telephone Company, joint petition for
5 approval of negotiated resale agreement dated
6 July 3rd, 2000, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. Section 252.

7 May I have the appearances for the

9 MS. JORGENSEN: On behalf of joint petitioner,
10 Ameritech, Illinois, I'm Mary Beth Jorgensen, 225
