REQUEST NO. IIEC 2.07:

Has ComEd made any estimate of the increase to the bills of its customers if there is "full AMI deployment" as Mr. Hemphill has used the term.

- a. If not, why not?
- b. If not, can such an estimate be made?
- c. If not, why can't such an estimate be made?
- d. Please provide the estimate assuming one has been made or can be made.

RESPONSE:

- a. As Dr. Hemphill expressly stated in his testimony, "the pilot will give us a better grasp of costs and benefits of a full AMI deployment. It will provide information not only about utility operational benefits, but also about how customers can use AMI technologies to conserve energy, save money, and benefit the environment" (ComEd Ex. 1.0, page 5, lines 89-92). Additionally, "proceeding to deploy advanced AMI technologies without a pilot would be more risky, more likely to be subject to technical delays, and more likely to fail to meet its full potential" (ComEd Ex. 1.0, page 18, lines 370-372). Moreover, the pilot will allow ComEd to "gain the data required to make a timely and informed decision (ComEd Ex. 1.0, page 48, lines 1032).
