3 At this time, we would ask the parties
4 to enter your respective appearances orally for the
5 record. If you entered an appearance at the earlier
6 hearing in these matters, you need not restate your
7 business address and phone number at this time unless

9 First, we will take the appearances on
10 behalf of the Ameren Illinois Utilities.

11 MR. FITZHENRY: Yes, Your Honor. This is Ed
12 Fitzhenry on behalf of the Ameren Illinois Utilities.

16 JUDGE JONES: Could we get your phone number in
17 there?

18 MR. FITZHENRY: Sure. Area code (314)554-3533.

19 JUDGE JONES: All right. Thank you.

20 Other appearances?

21 MR. FEELEY: Yes. Representing staff of the
22 Illinois Commerce Commission, this is John Feeley,

1 and also representing staff, Carmen Fosco from the
2 Office of General Counsel.

3 JUDGE JONES: Thank you.

4 Are there any other appearances to be
5 entered this morning?

6 Let the record show there are not, at
7 least at this time.

8 At this point, we will see if there is
9 a schedule or at least some scheduling to be
10 proposed.

11 I would ask that anyone who is going
12 to be speaking on the phone please identify yourself
13 before you do so so that our court reporter will
14 attribute your comments to you.

15 Is there scheduling to be proposed at
16 this time?

17 MR. FEELEY: This is John Feeley for staff.

18 Staff has some proposed dates that
19 it's our understanding the company does not object
20 to.

21 The first date would be staff and
22 intervenor direct testimony due April 14, 2010

1 followed up by a status on April 21, 2010, and the
2 reason that that date is needed for the testimony is,
3 you know, this is the first time this kind of matter
4 has come before Commission staff so it takes time to
5 become familiar with the issues.

6 Also, we have the three Ameren
7 companies here, so there's three separate
8 reconciliations, and also due to the staff involved,
9 their schedule in other matters that they're
10 handling, and that requires a date of April 14, 2010.

11 JUDGE JONES: Thank you.

12 Mr. Fitzhenry, are the Ameren Illinois
13 Utilities agreeable to those dates?

14 MR. FITZHENRY: Yes, Your Honor. This is Ed
15 Fitzhenry, and we are agreeable to the dates that
16 were offered by Mr. Feeley?

17 JUDGE JONES: Thank you.

18 With regard to the status, that date
19 is April 21, is that correct?

20 MR. FEELEY: This is John Feeley. That's
21 correct.

22 JUDGE JONES: Let's see, that's a commission

1 meeting date at 10:30, so we could do it ahead of
2 that or in the afternoon or on the 22nd.

3 What's the preference of the parties?

4 MR. FEELEY: The 22nd is fine if that's all
5 right with you and staff in Springfield.

6 John Feeley again. Sorry.

7 Or later on the 21st. It doesn't
8 matter.

9 JUDGE JONES: Did you want to go off the record
10 and consult with your staff members?

11 MR. FEELEY: Sure.

12 JUDGE JONES: All right. We'll go off the
13 record briefly for that purpose.

14 (Whereupon an off-the-record
15 discussion transpired at this
16 time.)

17 JUDGE JONES: All right. Back on the record.

18 There was a short off-the-record
19 discussion for the purposes indicated.

20 It's my understanding the parties are
21 agreeable to the status being held on April 22nd at
22 10 a.m. but let me make sure.

1 Mr. Feeley, does that work for you?

2 MR. FEELEY: This is John Feeley. Yes, Judge
3 Jones, that works for staff.

4 JUDGE JONES: And, Mr. Fitzhenry, is that
5 satisfactory to you?

6 MR. FITZHENRY: Yes, Your Honor.

7 JUDGE JONES: All right. So let the record
8 show that that scheduling that has been proposed with
9 that one clarification is hereby approved. Staff and
10 intervenor testimony will be filed on or before
11 April 14. Copies will be served electronically on
12 other parties and on me.

13 There will be a status hearing on
14 April 22nd at 10 a.m. Participation by phone will be
15 permitted. It will be used for further scheduling as
16 well as other prehearing conference type purposes.

17 I think that's it for today. I'll
18 check with the parties on that.

19 Does anyone else or does anyone have
20 any other matters to bring up at this time?

21 MR. FEELEY: This is John Feeley. Staff has
22 nothing else.

1 MR. FITZHENRY: This is Ed Fitzhenry. I'd like
2 a copy of the transcript, please.

3 JUDGE JONES: At this time then let the record
4 show that today's status hearing is concluded.

5 Our thanks to Ameren Illinois
6 Utilities for furnishing and circulating a call-in
7 number.
