In IAWC Exhibit 2.0R, Ms. Norton refers to the time IAWC takes to restore grounds after IAWC construction (lines 123 ff). For each district, please provide the average number of days between the completion of IAWC construction and the restoration of the grounds affected by IAWC construction.

**RESPONSE:**

The Company does not track the exact time between a dig and final restoration. Many factors influence the time to complete a restoration including:

- Availability of paving and/or restoration contractors, and the season that these contractors are able to work. For example, contractors in the northern part of the state have a shorter season than those in the southern part of the state.
- Availability of alternate backfill material (i.e. compacted stone; flowable fill).
- Ability to dispose of spoil.
- Weather conditions.
