**RECOMMENDATION:**

Pursuant to discussions held at the status conference on March 26, 2001 with respect to the Commission's grant of rehearing and the pending motions and responses regarding a Stay of the Order in 01-0065, we recommend the following action:

**Recommended Commission Ruling:**

The Stay of the Order in 01-0065 is lifted insofar as allowing Seamus Glynn to retain the confidential data at issue and continuing with the function of processing such data but only as an assist to Staff.

Mr. Glynn will not in any way use, disclose or share the data or the results of his processing of the data with any entity whatsoever other than Staff until an Order on Rehearing is entered in this cause. Lest there be any doubt, this restriction includes CUB as well as the governmental entities..

In all other respects, there is a Stay of the Commission's January 24, 2001 Order and the matter continues on rehearing.
