Re: APPLICATION OF ENERGY MANAGEMENT RESOURCES OF MISSOURI, INC. FOR A CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY TO BE AN ALTERNATIVE RETAIL ELECTRIC SUPPLIER UNDER SECTION 16-115 OF THE ILLINOIS PUBLIC UTILITIES ACT - *Motion to Withdraw Application to be an Alternative Retail Electric Supplier*

Dear Sir or Madam:

On January 14, 2010, Energy Management Resources of Missouri, Inc. ("Applicant") filed (a) an application ("Application") with the Illinois Commerce Commission (the "ICC") requesting a certificate of service authority to be an alternative retail electric supplier under Section 16-115 of the Illinois Public Utilities Act (the "Act"), and (b) a Motion For Confidential Treatment of Certain Application Information (the "Motion for Confidential Treatment"). On March 29, 2010, Applicant and its counsel received a letter dated March 25, 2010 and a copy of the Proposed Order, which proposes that the ICC (x) grant a Certificate of Service Authority to Applicant, and (y) reject Applicant's Motion for Confidential Treatment. Upon review of the Proposed Order, Applicant seeks to withdraw its application effective immediately. In support of Applicant's motion to withdraw its Application, Applicant states:

1. Applicant was seeking a certificate of service authority to be an alternative retail electric supplier under Section 16-115 of the Act. Applicant disclosed in its Application certain information that it seeks to protect from public dissemination, but the ICC, in its Proposed Order, declined to protect that information.
2. With this Motion, Applicant is seeking to withdraw its Application (including Attachments A, B and C) to protect the identities of certain employees, which Applicant desires to protect from public dissemination.



3. Applicant intends to further review the managerial qualifications set forth in Part 454.60 and the technical qualifications set forth in Part 454.70 of the Illinois Administrative Code, and submit a new application.

4. Applicant seeks an Order from the ICC, without hearing, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Act and the Illinois Administrative Code, granting withdrawal of the Application effective immediately. Applicant further requests the ICC to return to Applicant such information from its Application as has not been publicly disseminated.
