
Petitioner, Paula Johnson, in Formal Complaint Number 09-0193, hereby gives notice to the Illinois Commerce Commission of "Defective Rulings" entered March 5, 2010, pursuant to numerous documented "violations" of Administrative Regulations, Part 100: Standards of Behavior for Commissioners and Commission Employees and Petitioner's Tertiary Recusal Motion, as authorized by 28 U.S.C. §455, pleading a third and subsequent pleading for recusal and disqualification of Presiding Judge Tapia.

In addition to all rulings by the Presiding Judge Tapia in this cause being defective, null and void, the Respondents, to date, remain liable under a documented

Product Liability Claim pursuant to 735 ILCS 5/13 202, on the Defective Electronic Gas Meter Installed on the Building of 715 North 24th Street, East St. Louis, Illinois 62205 and the unlawful utility shut-off that resulted, and all damages.

In addition, the Commission remains liable for the unresolved matter set forth in Cause Number : 2008-SC-003553 in the 7th Circuit Judicial Court of Sangamon County, Illinois.

WHEREFORE, all Rulings and/or Orders entered March 5, 2010 are “defective”, “null” and “void”, and for reasons set forth above and in Petitioners attached **Exhibits “A”** Cause Number 2008 SC 3553 Johnson VS. Commission, **Exhibits “B”** Petitioner’s Tertiary Recusal Motion of Judge Tapia, and **Exhibit “C”** Petitioner’s Second Request to Appear Electronically due to Disability and Cost, no issues have been resolved and those issues remain. The Liability of the Respondents remain in addition to the Breach of Duty of the Commission under the “Illinois State Commerce Commission Tax” collected Monthly from Petitioner.
