

STAFF'S ANSWER TO THE PETITION

Now comes the Staff of the Illinois Commerce Commission (Staff) and in support of its Answer to the Will County 9-1-1 System's Petition for Approval of a Modification to Illinois Commerce Commission Docket 92-0122, states the following:

1. The Will County 9-1-1 System received an order to operate its Enhanced 9-1-1 System from the Commission on August 5, 1992, in Docket 92-0122.
2. On April 1, 2010, the Will County 9-1-1 System filed a Petition for Approval of a Modification to Illinois Commerce Commission Docket 92-0122 in which it requests to incorporate the Village of Bolingbrook into its 9-1-1 system upon receipt of a Final Order from this Commission.
3. The Village of Bolingbrook, in Docket 10-0258, has filed a petition to dismiss the authority to operate an E9-1-1 system granted in Docket 91-0342 due to the fact that Bolingbrook intends to join the Will County 9-1-1 System. Bolingbrook has passed a corporate resolution indicating their desire to abandon their existing 9-1-1 dispatch system and to incorporate said system into the Will County 9-1-1 System.
4. Bolingbrook also passed a corporate resolution rescinding the authority of the Bolingbrook Emergency Telephone System Board (ETSB) and has entered into an intergovernmental agreement with the Will County 9-1-1 System to create a joint ETSB pursuant to 50 ILCS Act 750 Sec. 15.4.
5. Staff has thoroughly reviewed the Will County 9-1-1 System's Petition for Approval of a Modification to Illinois Commerce Commission Docket 92-0122 and supports the petitioners' request for modification. In addition, Staff supports waiving a hearing in this docket.






