Deborah Kirchmann, hereby requests that the Illinois Commerce Commission grant it a license pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act. In support of its application, Applicants states as follows:

I am Deborah Kirchmann, Account Manager, company name is American Energy Analysis Inc., which is an Illinois corporation which was created in January 1992, doing business at 503 South Main Street, Sycamore, IL 60178. My telephone is 815.899.3866, fax number is 815.899.3868, email is debbie.kirchmann@aeaenergy.com. A copy of our State of Illinois registration is included.

American Energy Analysis Inc. was formed in January 1992, and has a small client base where we monitor electric/natural gas bills for our customers, check for their accuracy, we do yearly reporting, work with budgeting of utility bills. We work with maintenance personnel in guiding them in directions of saving energy in their buildings. We also do their RFP for procurement of electric and natural gas contracts. We are independent and are paid only by our customers for time spent on these projects. We are a small company with four employees of which only one, myself deal with electric procurement with a handful of customers.

When procuring electric and natural gas contracts for my client base RFP's are sent to all suppliers listed as retail suppliers within the area of our customers. All retail suppliers are asked to provide pricing on the same sheet (example enclosed). After proposals are received we compile the data and present to our customers. Our customers make the final decision as to which suppliers they are choosing.

American Energy Analysis Inc., Deborah Kirchmann has been doing this since 1992 and has kept the same client base since that time. Over the course of the last 18 years we wrote a computer program that checked the accuracies of their electric and natural gas bills, kept track of their payments, and gave them monthly and yearly reporting. We have worked with the utilities to correct bills and made sure our customers were accurately given credits. We attend as many conferences that are available and stay abreast to the energy markets through the internet and through the ComEd website and rate book.

We do not have a marketing program as our customer base is very small and because we do many more tasks for our customers other than their energy contracts. We do keep copies of all correspondence and bills for our customers for three years. We will comply with all regulations within this license.

I request that the Commission grant me a license to engage in the procurement of retail electric supply.
